Proposal is to expand an existing dock with the new dock having a 6' x 126' fixed wood pier, a 3' x 45' gangway, a 6' x 16' landing float, and an 8' x 38' float, adjacent to the tidal Piscataqua River. The project creates 1,015 square feet of permanent impact to tidal wetlands.
