

ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

FINANCIAL MEETING - May 22, 1980

Members Present: Chairperson Proulx, G. Lamoureux, R. Shortill, A. MacVane and alternate member A. Barr.

Moved by Lamoureux, seconded by Barr, to accept minutes of May 1, 1980 meeting as written. Unanimously approved.

Review and discussion of financial report (covering January, 1980 to present).
Moved by Barr, seconded by MacVane, to accept financial report as written.
Unanimously approved.

Discussion ensued as to the enforcement of the Zoning Board's rulings and lack of said enforcement. It was decided that Secretary L. Eastwood would send memorandums to the appropriate people questioning the enforcement and lack thereof in cases H80-10, Sullivan and H78-17, Cragin (Colony Beauty Salon).

Discussion ensued in reference to the appointment of members and alternates to the Board and it was decided that the Chairperson write a memorandum to the City Council and Mayor suggesting that the terms of appointment run from June 1st to May 31st of each year for all Boards and Commissions, thereby giving the Council ample time to consider or re-consider each applicant. It was decided that if the Council acted favorably with this suggestion, the Zoning Board of Adjustment would change their By-Laws so that the election of officers would take place in the month of June.

A thorough review of the ZBA's By-Laws will take place in the near future.
