

November 22, 1948

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:45 PM with Chairman J.C. Lawless presiding. Mr. Samuel B. Blair was named Secretary pro tem. Present were: Mr. James C. Lawless, Mr. E. W. Christensen, Mr. James P. Behan, Mr. Samuel B. Blair, Mr. Orville L. Evans, Mr. James P. Murphy. Absent were: Mr. Gordon L. Fox, Mr. Harold A. Holbrook, Mr. Woodbury E. Brackett.

On a motion by Mr. Blair, the director was authorized to co-operate with Martin Smith, government student at the Univ. N. H., who is compiling a community survey of Dover, for a term paper at the University, with the understanding that no expense to the board would be incurred.

After an item by item explanation of the 1949 budget by the director, the budget calling for total estimated expenditures of \$3,300, as submitted by the director and the finance committee was adopted unanimously. The motion to adopt the budget was made by Mr. Behan, seconded by Mr. Blair.

Progress on the traffic study and suggestions for further studies on this project were discussed generally without formal action. The meeting adjourned at 8:55 PM on motion by Mr. Evans.
