The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:45 P. M. with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

In the absence of Mr. Holbrook, Mr. J. F. Murphy was named secretary pro tem. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, J. F. Murphy, J. F. Behan, J. H. McAdams, and E. W. Christensen.

The resignation of Mr. Blair was read and accepted to be forwarded to the City Council. Mr. Christensen made a motion that the secretary send a letter thanking Mr. Blair for his services.

A motion was then passed for Mr. Bills to attend a state-wide Municipal Planning conference at The Weirs, June 1.

The Executive Director reported on progress in the Building Code and the Traffic Survey projects. A motion was made by Mr. Christensen that Mr. Bills contact Mr. Wayland of the Public Roads Administration, to see if action on the traffic survey can be speeded up.

Mr. Bills then explained the spot survey in the Third, Fourth, Fifth and Lincoln Street area. The Knox Marsh Road, local business zone was then discussed, but action was delayed.

A motion was made by Mr. Murphy that the meeting be adjourned at 9:00.
