The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:40 P. M. with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

In the absence of Mr. Holbrook, Mr. J. F. Murphy was named secretary pro tem. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, J. F. Murphy, J. F. Behan, J. H. McAdams, and A. E. Alie.

The Director discussed the changes in the zoning laws by the State Legislature, and how they would effect the Planning Board, and the enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance.


It was voted unanimously that the Director attend the National Planning Conference in Cleveland, Ohio, October 9-12.
