

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

January 23, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:40 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, J. H. McAdams, A. E. Alie, H. A. Holbrook, E. W. Christensen, and P. W. Pease.

After a lengthy discussion on the proposed re-zoning of the local business district at the junction of the Knox Marsh and Littleworth Roads, referred back to the Board by the City Council at its last meeting, it was decided that action on the matter be delayed pending further study. The Director and Chairman were directed to make a detailed survey of the area. The matter was tabled for further study on a motion by Mr. Holbrook, seconded by Mr. Christensen.

The Board authorized the Director to begin work on a study of sub-division development, and regulations for the acceptance of new streets by the city.

The Director then gave a progress report on the Board's survey of traffic congestion in the retail business area.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Holbrook.
