

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

February 27, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:40 P.M., by E. W. Christensen, appointed temporary Chairman in the absence of J. C. Lawless, presided at the meeting.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: H. A. Holbrook, A. E. Alie, J. F. Murphy, P. W. Pease, and E. W. Christensen.

Following a detailed discussion of the proposed re-zoning of the local business district at the junction of the Knox Marsh and Littleworth Roads, the Board voted to report to the City Council that it recommends no change in the zoning map at this time. On the motion to recommend no change, Holbrook, Alie, Murphy and Pease voted yes, and Christensen voted no.

The Director discussed the street acceptance and sub-division development program, and it was voted that he begin work immediately on this project, and table, temporarily, his work on the traffic study.

On a motion by Mr. Christensen, seconded by Mr. Alie, it was voted that Mr. Murphy's name be submitted to the City Council for re-appointment to the Planning Board. His term expires March 7, 1950.

There was a general discussion of the traffic study, with the Director giving a report on the work completed to date.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Alie.
