

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

March 27, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:35 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, P. W. Peese, A. E. Alie, J. H. McAdams, H. A. Holbrook, and J. F. Behan.

After a lengthy discussion of the proposed re-zoning of the local business district at the junction of Knox Marsh and Littleworth Roads, the Board voted to delay action pending a meeting with the City Council at a later date.

The new maps, prepared for the use of the public, were shown to the Board members. On a motion by Mr. Holbrook, seconded by Mr. Behan, it was voted unanimously that the maps be sold for \$.60.

The traffic study reports that were intended for the Retail Merchants banquet, but due to unexpected problems, were not used, were shown to the Board members, and it was decided that the reports should be mailed to the merchants with a letter explaining the work done so far on it.

The Director discussed at some length the work done on the street acceptance and sub-division development program.

The election of officers was postponed until the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Behan.
