

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

April 3, 1950

A special meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 9:45 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, P. W. Pease, A. E. Alie, J. H. McAdams, H. A. Holbrook, J. F. Murphy, R. L. Price, and E. W. Christensen.

It was voted to conduct public hearings on the following proposed amendment to the City Zoning Ordinance:

- a. To change the zoning classification from local business to single residence, on a strip of land 300 feet by 200 feet approximately on both sides of the Littleworth Road, beginning at the junction of the Knox Marsh Road.
- b. To amend Section I of the Ordinance by adding the following paragraph:
  - D. Buildings divided by district lines.

Where a district boundary line divided a building erected prior to the time such line is adopted, the regulations for the less restricted portion of the building shall apply for the entire building.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Alie.
