

## PLANNING BOARD MEETING

April 27, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:45 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

In the absence of Mr. Holbrook, Mr. Pease was appointed Secretary Pro Tempore. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, P. W. Pease, J. F. Murphy, and J. F. Behan.

A decision on the Board's recommendation to the City Council on the proposed re-zoning of the local business district at the Knox Marsh and Littleworth Roads, was postponed until a special meeting when it is expected more members of the Board will be present.

The traffic problem was discussed at some length, and the Director gave a report of a recent meeting in the City Manager's office, with members of the Traffic Committee of the Retail Merchants Association present, to discuss the traffic situation in the City.

There was a general discussion of the sub-division development and control program, with the Director giving a report on the work completed to date.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Behan.
