

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

May 9, 1950

A special meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:35 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, J. F. Murphy, J. F. Behan, H. A. Holbrook, A. E. Alie, P. W. Pease, and J. H. McAdams.

The purpose of the meeting was to make a recommendation to the City Council concerning the zoning of the local business area at the Know Marsh and Littleworth Roads. Quite a bit of discussion followed the Director's report of the public hearing held on this matter. On a motion by Mr. Holbrook, seconded by Mr. McAdams, it was voted unanimously to recommend to the Council that no change be made in the area at this time.

During a short recess the Director composed a letter to be presented to the City Council, giving the Board's reasons for this action. The letter was read and approved by the Board for transmittal to the City Council at its next regular meeting on Thursday, April the 11th.

On a motion by Mr. McAdams, seconded by Mr. Holbrook, the following amendment to Section I of the Zoning Ordinance was approved as a recommendation to the City Council:

C-1. Buildings divided by district lines. Where a district boundary line divides a building erected prior to the time such line is adopted, the regulations for the less restricted portion of the building shall ~~rep~~ apply for the entire building.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Behan.
