

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

May 22, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:30 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, H. A. Holbrook, A. E. Alie, J. F. Murphy, E. W. Christensen, J. F. Behan, and R. L. Price, and also J. H. McAdams.

The Board accepted the Director's monthly report summarizing the Board's work on sub-division control, zoning, and traffic.

The Director was requested to write to Concord for copies of the Concord Sub-Division Control Ordinance.

Four proposals for the improvement of traffic conditions were read and discussed by the Board at some length. No formal action was taken on any of these proposals.

The Director, the Chairman, and the City Manager were requested to investigate the feasibility of obtaining additional off-street parking areas as a part of proposal Number One, which calls for an improvement of traffic flow on Central Avenue.

Further investigation of the details of the proposal to develop Chestnut and Walnut Streets into a second through way, were also requested by the Board.

The meeting adjourned at 10:15 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Murphy.
