

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

June 27, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:30 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, H. A. Holbrook, J. F. Murphy, J. F. Behan, and P. W. Pease.

The Director gave a report of the sub-committee's investigation of off-street parking facilities. On a motion by Mr. Holbrook, seconded by Mr. Murphy, the Board voted to accept the sub-committee's report relative to the American House lot for off-street parking purposed.

The Director presented a rough draft of the traffic report to be presented to the Council, along with some cost figures prepared by the State Highway Department for the Chestnut Street-Walnut Street proposal. It was discussed at some length. The Board approved the essence of the report and asked the Director to get it in final shape to be discussed at the next regular meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M., on a motion by Mr. Behan.
