

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

September 25, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:50 P.M., by J. H. McAdams, appointed temporary Chairman in the absence of J. C. Lawless, presided at the meeting.

In the absence of H. A. Holbrook, P. W. Pease was appointed Secretary Pro Tempore.

The minutes of the meetings of July 25 and August 28, were read and approved.

Members present were: J. H. McAdams, P. W. Pease, A. E. Alie, J. F. Behan, and R. L. Price.

The Director discussed the recently organized New Hampshire Association of Planning and Zoning Agencies, and suggested that the local Board join this organization. On a motion by J.F. Behan, seconded by R. L. Price, it was voted unanimously that the Dover Planning Board become a member of the state organization, and the Director was authorized to pay the annual dues of \$15.00.

The Director reported on the progress being made in re-activating the sub-committee to work on a Building Code. P. W. Pease brought up the point that perhaps work on sub-division control was more important at the present time. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that the projects were equally important and that both could be worked on at the same time.

There followed reports by the Director and discussions of several projects including a few minor changes in the Zoning Ordinance, the Recreation study, and the work being done by the Housing Authority.

City Manager R. L. Price told the Board of a letter he had received from a student who would like to intern with the Planning Board.

On a motion by A. E. Alie, seconded by J. F. Behan, it was voted

unanimously that the Director attempt to secure the services of such an intern for the remainder of the year.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M., on a motion by J. F. Behan.
