

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

November 27, 1950

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:30 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Members present were: J. C. Lawless, P. W. Pease, A. F. Alie, H. A. Holbrook, and W. W. Christensen.

The Director reported on several projects including the progress being made in re-activating the sub-committee to work on the Building Code, and the second edition of the "Traffic Study", and also the work being done on a sub-Division Ordinance.

Work has been started on a general overhaul of the Zoning Ordinance and Map. William Ganster, Management Intern, is assisting the Director in a land use survey as a part of this project.

There followed a general discussion of the traffic and parking problems in the City. The Director was asked to see what could be done about providing adequate parking facilities in the not-too-distant future.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 P.M., on a motion by H. A. Holbrook.
