The Director gave a brief report on the progress being made by the Dover Housing Authority.

The field surveys for the land use plan were completed during the month, and the maps showing existing uses of the land were shown to the Board members. The Director explained the importance of such a plan in much of the work planned for the coming year.

As directed at the last meeting, potential off-street parking areas were investigated during the month, but the work has not progressed far enough for the Board to make a definite recommendation to the City Council. The Director said he would try to have the necessary data ready for the next meeting.

Mr. McAdams, Chairman of the sub-committee working on the Building Code, reported on the progress being made by that group.

The Director was given authority to postpone the regular meeting scheduled for February 26 to March 5, if he deems it advisable.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M. on a motion by J. H. McAdams.
