

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

March 25, 1951

The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 7:45 P.M., with Chairman J. C. Lawless presiding.

Members present were: Lawless, Holbrook, Alie, McAdams, and Pease.

Members absent were: Murphy, Behan, Christensen, and Price.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary.

On motion by Mr. Alie seconded by Mr. McAdams the minutes were accepted and placed on file.

A report on off-street parking, prepared for submission to the City Council was discussed in detail. Mr. McAdams moved that the report be amended by striking the words "tax monies" from the fourth line of Section V and inserting the words "by funds specifically earmarked from the parking meter revenue," so that the sentence will read; "It is the opinion of the Planning Board that this bond issue should be amortized by funds specifically ear-marked from the parking meter revenue and that the parking lot should be available for use by the public without any charge whatsoever." The motion was seconded by Mr. Holbrook and adopted unanimously.

Mr. McAdams moved that the report as amended be accepted and submitted to the City Council at the earliest possible date. The motion was seconded by Mr. Holbrook and adopted unanimously.

The Director led a discussion of the progress to date on the revised land use plan. On motion by Mr. Pease seconded by Mr. Holbrook the Board voted to temporarily defer further work on the land use plan and expedite work on a proposed sub-division regulation ordinance.

On motion made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn.

The meeting adjourned at 9:55 P.M.
