A proposed ordinance relative to zoning regulations in the city of Dover was read and discussed fully. After a long discussion a number of changes and insertions were made. The discussion of this proposed ordinance will be continued at the next regular meeting.

A report on Off-Street Parking was distributed by the Executive Director and read by the members. This report recommends the establishment of a 120-car off-street parking lot on First Street and a reduction in the parking time limit in the parking meter area on Central Avenue between Washington Street and Third Street, from two hours to one hour. On a motion by Mr. Pease seconded by Mr. Price the Director was instructed to add a paragraph estimating the cost of changing over these meters. On a motion by Mr. McAdams seconded by Mr. Pease it was unanimously voted to accept the report as amended and forward said report to the City Council.

On motion duly made and seconded it was voted to adjourn.
