The regular meeting of the City Planning Board was called to order at 8:15 P.M. in the office of the Planning Board in the Municipal Building with Chairman James C. Lawless presiding.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary. Upon motion by Mr. Christensen, seconded by Mr. McAdams, it was unanimously voted to accept the minutes as read.

Upon motion by Mr. Holbrook, seconded by Mr. Price, it was unanimously voted to authorize the Executive Director to attend the National Planning Conference in Pittsburg, Oct. 14-17.

Report of the Executive Director was read and discussed. On motion by Mr. Pease, seconded by Mr. Christensen, the report of the Director was approved as read and placed on file.

Following a discussion of traffic and parking, the Director was authorized to make a further study of the need for additional parking meters and the change in the time limit allowed at some metered spaces and to report his findings at the next meeting.

After a generalized discussion of subdivision control, the Director was authorized to prepare a text of a Subdivision Ordinance for Dover, to ask for a review of the proposal by the City Solicitor and to call a special meeting of the Board to act on this proposal after it has been reviewed by the City Solicitor.

A discussion of proposed changes in the Zoning Ordinance begun at the previous meeting was continued.

On motion duly made and seconded, it was voted to adjourn at 10:15 P.M.
