

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

7 April 1952

Regular monthly meeting of Dover City Planning Board called to order by Chairman Meserve at 7:30 P. M. April 7, 1952.

Members present: Meserve, Behan, Guilmette, Hall, Stevens and Nealley.

Also present: City Engineer Pike, City Solicitor Jackson, Public Works Director Myers, Attorney Fisher, and Mr. Bernard, Building Inspector.

Mr. Fisher spoke on a proposed plan for a new street off Greenwood Avenue, and coming out on Sixth Street. This street was to be named as Vallee Street.

A motion was made by Behan, seconded by Nealley, that we refer the petition presented by New Homes Inc., for the acceptance of Vallee Street to the City Engineer for further investigation. Motion unanimously adopted.

A motion was made by Hall and seconded by Stevens, that under existing conditions, the Planning Board go on record as disapproving the new street, off Smith Well Road. (Adopted unanimously.)

It was moved by Guilmette seconded by Stevens that the Dover Planning Board recommends the acceptance of the sub-division regulations, subject to Section 7 of Ordinance 20, before final adoption. Unanimously carried.

It was moved by Nealley seconded by Behan, that we adjourn.
