

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

5 May 1952

The regular monthly meeting of the Dover City Planning Board was called to order on Monday, May 5, 1952, at 7:30 P. M., in the Planning Board Room.

Members present: Meserve, Guilmette, Nealley, Hall, Stevens and Behan.

Mr. Bernard, Building Inspector, was also present.

A petition from New Homes, Inc. was read, asking for approval of Vallee Street by the Planning Board.

It was moved by Hall, seconded by Stevens, that under conditions recommended by the City Engineer, Vallee Street be accepted for a distance of approximately 175 feet. Unanimously adopted.

A petition from Guy S. Merrill was read, relative to the building and maintenance of new proposed street by Mr. Merrill.

A motion made by Stevens, seconded by Nealley, that the petition of Guy S. Merrill be held for further investigation.

Motion carried unanimously.

A discussion of a public hearing on sub-division regulations was held and a date was to be set by Chairman Meserve as to when

this hearing would take place.

Motion to adjourn by Behan seconded by Hall.
