

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

September 10, 1952

A regular meeting of the Planning Board was held this Wednesday, September 10, 1952., in the Planning Board Room, Municipal Building.

The following members were present at roll call: Chairman Eugene S. Meserve, Hall, Stevens, Nealley, DuBois, Bernard, and Guilmette.

Also in attendance were: City Engineer Crawford and City Solicitor Jackson.

On a motion by Nealley seconded by DuBois it was voted to suspend with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting.

After considerable and amiable discussion and deliberation of the regulations pertaining to the Sub-Development Ordinance #20 it was unanimously voted by a roll call of 7 yeas, 0 naes, and 2 absent to adopt the so called regulations to become effective as of this date.

Motion by Hall seconded by Bernard.

The petition of Glencrest Inc., for the acceptance of Crescent Avenue and the construction of a water main and a sewer thereon was laid on the table for further study and consideration on a motion by Nealley seconded by Stevens.

The petition of Frederick Pearson, Jr., was discussed and it was voted to get more information from Mr. Pearson before taking any action.

On a motion by Stevens seconded by Hall it was voted to adjourn.
