

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

A regular meeting of the Planning Board was held this Monday, October 6, 1952., in the Planning Board room, Municipal Building.

Also present were: City Solicitor Jackson and City Engineer Crawford.

Also in attendance were: Walter Fischer and Grant L. Davis who spoke on behalf of the Carville Tract and Glencrest Inc. Developments.

On a motion by Stevens seconded by Nealley it was voted to dispense with reading the minutes of the last meeting.

On a motion by DuBois seconded by Bernard it was voted to refer the Carville Tract Sub-Development to the City Engineer for study and to report back as soon as possible.

On a motion by Stevens seconded by Bernard it was voted to reject the petition of Glencrest Inc., on the grounds that the petition is in the nature of a contract with the city and this Board has no jurisdiction in such matters.

On a motion by DuBois seconded by Nealley it was voted to refer the petition of Theodore Skonberg for water main construction on the Garrison Road to the City Engineer for study and approximate cost and to report back at the next meeting.

On a motion by Stevens seconded by Nealley it was voted to adjourn.
