

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

5 January 1953

The monthly meeting of the Planning Board was held this Monday, January 5, 1953, at 7:30 P. M. in the Planning Board Office, Municipal Building.

The following members were present at roll call: Chairman Eugene S. Meserve, DuBois, Bernard, Stevens, Hall, Nealley and Guilmette.

On a motion by Stevens seconded by DuBois it was voted to dispense with reading of the minutes of the previous meeting which was held December 1st, 1952.

The petition of Annie A. Keefe for the acceptance of a proposed new street off the Back River Road was referred to the City Engineer for an investigation and report when he receives the plans from the Chairman of this Board, Eugene Meserve, who in turn is to secure said plans from Keefe and Keefe, Attorneys for Annie A. Keefe.


On a motion by Stevens seconded by Bernard it was unanimously voted that the petition from Glencrest, Inc., dated December 15, 1952, for the acceptance of Crescent Avenue as a

proposed street be approved and accepted as soon as they have complied with the regulations and requirements of the Engineering and Highway departments, and it is further recommended that the construction of water and sewer mains be installed in accordance with present city regulations as needed.

There being no further business it was voted to adjourn on a motion by Stevens seconded by Hall.
