

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

5 March 1953

Regular meeting of the Planning Board was called to order at 7:30 P. M., March 5, 1953. Members present: Meserve, Hall, Nealley, Stevens, Bernard and DuBois.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted.

The City Engineer reported on the petition of Frederick Pearson, Jr., and recommended that Mr. Pearson submit a profile of the proposed street. A motion, was made by Stevens and seconded by Bernard that the recommendation of the City Engineer be followed and the Board request Mr. Pearson for a profile of his proposed development. The motion was carried unanimously.

The petition of Knox Park Inc. for the installation of sewerage, water and road was discussed. A motion was made by Hall seconded by Stevens requesting Knox Park Inc. furnish the Board with a profile of the proposed Road. The motion was passed unanimously.

The petition of Annie A. Keefe was considered and a motion made by Nealley, seconded by Stevens, that the petitioner be requested to submit a plat showing plan of lots and profile.

The motion was passed unanimously.

The Board discussed the petition of Francis Cassely, Jr. and a motion was made by Bernard seconded by Nealley that the City Engineer contact Mr. Cassily and discuss with him the proposed petition and report back to the Board as soon as possible. The motion was carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn was made by Nealley seconded by Bernard. Adjourned at 9:25 P. M.
