

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

6 April 1953

The regular monthly meeting of the Dover City Planning Board was held in the Planning Board Room at 7:30 P. M., on Monday, April 6, 1953, with Chairman Eugene Meserve presiding. Members present were: Meserve, Stevens, Behan, Guilmette, Nealley, Hall, DuBois and Bernard. City Engineer Crawford was also present.

Several petitions were presented and action taken upon them in the following manner:

1. It was moved by Behan seconded by Bernard that the Plat~~o~~ as presented by Francis Cassilly, Jr., for a proposed street near 124 Sixth Street be accepted. The proposed street, not to exceed 300 feet, with a turn around of a 50 ft. radius at the end of the street and the extension of a water and sewer main, in accordance with present city regulations, previous to the acceptance of this street by the City Council. Motion passed unanimously.

2. A motion was made by Stevens seconded by Nealley, that the Plat~~o~~ submitted by the Knox Park Inc. and the Petitioners Kenneth V. Couser and Shyrlee Ann Couser, dated Feb. 1952 for the extension of 340 ft. of Hartswood Rd. be accepted. Motion unani-

mously carried.

3. It was moved by Bernard seconded by Stevens to accept the Plat<sup>1</sup> submitted by Frederick C. Pearson Jr., dated April 25, 1952. Motion adopted unanimously.

4. A motion was made by Stevens seconded by Guilmette, that the petition of Robert Labrie be referred to the City Engineer for further study, and that he report back at an early date. Motion unanimously carried.

5. Motion to adjourn by Stevens, seconded by Bernard. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 9:25 P. M.
