

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

8 February 1954

A meeting of the Planning Board called to order at 7:30 by
Chm. Meserve.

Members present; Bernard, Behan, Hall, Nealley, DuBois,
Meserve and Stevens.

Minutes of the previous meeting was read and accepted.

Nomination was placed for the election of Chairman as follows:
Eugene Meserve. Vote nomination cease. Motion made. Secretary
cast one vote for Eugene Meserve as Chairman.

Nomination for Secretary: Arthur DuBois. Vote nomination
cease. Motion made. Secretary cast one vote for Arthur DuBois as
Secretary.

A general discussion was held by the members on the parking
situation in the city. Several points were brought out by the
members for study. A call was made to the Police Department for
the number of Parking Meters in the city. According to the officer
on the desk there is about 400 meters in Dover.

A motion by Bernard seconded by Behan that meetings of the
Planning Board be held on the first Monday of the month.

It was decided that all members of the Board would investigate the parking spaces and report at the next meeting.

The secretary was requested to send a letter to the Chairman of the Merchants Association asking him to appoint a committee of three members to meet with the planning board at its next meeting regarding to parking problem.

A motion was made by Bernard seconded by Nealley that the City Government be requested for an appropriation in the sum of \$300. for expenses in the forthcoming year for the Planning Board. Vote unanimous.

A motion was made by Stevens seconded by Behan to adjourn.
Motion passed unanimously.
