

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

1 March 1954

A meeting of the Planning Board was held at 7:30 P. M. in the Planning Board Room, Municipal Building.

In absence of the Chairman, the Secretary opened the meeting.

Mr. Webb presented a proposed plat of Berry Street in the Brook Development. Mr. Webb said he would file a petition in regards to this development.

Mr. Johnson, Mr. Lawless, Mr. Adams of the Dover Retail Merchants Association were present to discuss the parking situation. Mr. Johnson stated that a survey was taken and it was found that most of the recurrent offenders were not merchants but professional men. The members of the Association wish to go on record in favor of using the net revenue received from the parking meter collections to specifically be applied to the purchase and upkeep of a suitable parking area. It was also recorded that parking meters be installed on Main Street from the Vocational School towards the Avenue.

After a brief discussion by the Board Members on the parking situation the meeting adjourned.
