

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

June 27, 1955

Meeting of the Planning Board called to order at 7:45 June 27, 1955  
by Chairman Reserve.

Members present were: Reserve, Hall, Nealley, Bernard, Fischer,  
and DuBois.

The City Solicitor and City Engineer were also present.

Application of Guy Merrill for a revised plat on Lt. Pleasant Heights  
was read and referred to the City Engineer for study and report  
back. Debated June 1955.

Moved by Nealley seconded by Bernard.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Fischer requested that he had placed advertisements in two magazines  
advertising for a Planning Director and so far the city hasn't had  
any reply from these ads.

The City Solicitor and City Engineer reported on a proposed plat  
of Tom Massingham for the moving of Floral Avenue so Tom Massingham  
could sell his lots as laid out on his new plat dated April 1954.

Motion by Fischer seconded by DuBois that the Planning Board recommend  
that the proposed street called Pleasant View Avenue (to be renamed  
later) as above or preliminary plat submitted by Thomas Massingham  
dated April 1954 be accepted.

Motion passed unanimous.

Motion to adjourn by Bernard seconded by Nealley.
