April 1, 1957

Members present: Reserve, Dubois, Labrie, McDonald, Fischer, and Tealley.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Reserve. The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously accepted.

Mr. T.L. Lindrus and Mr. Grant Davis were present to discuss the Gage's Mill Development of Mr. Lindrus. The question of where the drainage would go was the main point of discussion, since the culvert across Central Avenue is too high to be connected to this project. The motion was made and seconded that Mr. Davis revise the plan and then these new plans would be presented at a special meeting with the Planning Board, New Hampshire State Highway Department, City Engineer, Public Works Superintendent, City Solicitor, Mr. Lindrus and Mr. Davis. The vote was unanimous.

A discussion of the Inruce area development of C.I. White was held. The motion was made by Fischer, seconded by Dubois that the plan be tabled subject to conference with the Planning Director and Mr. White with the exact plans.

Motion to adjourn by Labrie. Seconded by Tealley. Vote unanimous.
