

CITY PLANNING BOARD

April 25, 1957

Members present: Fisher, Mcalley, Labrie, McDonald, O'Keill, DuBois, and Chairman Reserve.

At this special meeting of the Planning Board the Board voted to table the revised plan of the Gage's Hill Development of Mr. W.L. Findrus until the next regular scheduled meeting. It was also decided to contact the City Solicitor to see if a drainage easement can be obtained from the city in connection with the problem of drainage in the area of Lorin Street and Central Avenue. Motion by Labrie, seconded by Fischer to table the project until the next regular meeting. The vote was unanimous.

A general discussion was held, at the request of the City Council, to study the proposed site of the dump at the "Hoppers". After a report by the Planning Director listing the advantages and disadvantages of this site, the Board recommended that the Planning Director draw up a report along the lines presented for recommendation to the City Council.

A general review of the Planning Director's work was discussed with a presentation by him, on his work.

Motion to adjourn by DuBois, seconded by Labrie. The vote was unanimous.
