

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

June 3, 1957

Members present: Nealley, McDonald, Meserve, O'Neil, Labrie and DuBois.

The revised plan of Oak Hill Development by Wamaca Inc. was tentatively approved. Motion was made by Labrie, seconded by Nealley. Vote unanimous.

A letter from Mr. H.L. Pindrus request'ing the board to re-consider its action on the Gage's Hill Development was read. Motion by O'Neil, seconded by Nealley that the Planning Director write to Mr. Pindrus requesting him to meet with the Mayor and the City Council requesting the easement across Central Avenue. When the easement is obtained he should then re-submit his plans to the Planning Board. Vote unanimous.

The Planning Director spoke to the board regarding his report on the Fire Station in the Dover Point-Back River area. The motion was made and seconded to include in the report the recommendation that the Central Fire Station be expanded. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Caso spoke to the board explaining the work that had been done in regard to the City Dump.
