

SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD MEETING

September 26, 1957

Members Present: Labrie, Fisher, McDonald, DuBois, Meserve

Motion by Fisher, seconded by McDonald that the petition, dated August 7, 1957, to the City Council from Elmer E. Eldredge requesting a permit to store and sell petroleum products (gasoline and oil) at his establishment on Sixth St. and referred to the Planning Board for its recommendation be referred by the petitioner to the Zoning Board of Adjustment, since the petition involves the extension of a non-conforming uses in an agricultural zone. All information including maps, plans, and other data collected by the Planning Director shall be given to the Zoning Board of Adjustment in order to expedite action on the petition if and when it is received by the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Motion unanimously adopted.

After further discussion to the appointment of a sub-committee to study a long-vauge Capital improvement program for the City as requested by Mayor Keenan, steps to be taken to provide for the efficient and orderly replacement of the present Planning Director, and progress on other pending matters, a motion to adjourn was placed before the Board and adopted.
