

SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD MEETING
JULY 28, 1958

A special meeting of the Planning Board was held on Monday, July 28, 1958, in the Planning Office, City Hall. Those members present were Mr. Meserve, Mr. Labrie, Mr. Fischer, Mr. Nealley, Mr. Farrar, and Director Skinner. Mr. Meserve, Chairman of the Board, called the meeting to order at 7:50 p.m.

Mr. Fischer called for the Development of McKenna Tract of Land by Wamaco, Inc.

On a motion by Labrie, seconded by Nealley, the petition of Wamaco, Inc. for development of the McKenna Tract is given tentative approval subject to the recommendations as stated in the letter dated July 28, 1958, from the Public Works and Water Department. It was unanimously passed.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by Farrar, that the Planning Board can not grant permission for Mobilehomes to Everett Pitman because he is in a residential area. The motion was passed.
