Motion by Meserve seconded by Healley that the Planning Director get from the City Solicitor draft an amendment to zoning ordinance relative to the rezoning of the Industrial Park Area.

Mr. Case spoke of a meeting with the Dover Point Advisory Committee in regards of land use area.

Motion to adjourn by Meserve seconded by DuBois.
