Meeting of Planning Board, May 15, 1956.

Motion by O'Neil seconded by Meserve to extend water main on Durham Road, 6 tenths of a mile, subject to Ordinance #8.

Vote unanimous.

Motion by DuBois seconded by Fischer that Planning Director communicate with City Solicitor with regards to filing a complaint against Joseph Gote of Dover Point, Sandy Point area, he is proceeding illegally on conditions set forth on tentative plat approval of July 12, 1954. Also enter complaint as regards now confirming use on Sixth Street of Mr. Wiel (Junk Yard). Also enter complaint against V. Cogswell now confirming use on Ash Street storing tractors in a residential area. Also enter complaint against Michael Nadeau on Sixth Street.

Vote unanimous.

Motion by DuBois seconded by Labrie that Planning Board hold a Public Hearing on June 4, 1956, relative to amendments to the zoning ordinance to establish a new district called Tourist Business and to establish a Mobile Home park district.
