Meeting of Planning Board, November 19, 1956.

Members present were: Fischer, O'Neil, Nealley, and McDonald, Chairman.

Mr. Lawless, representing Lucien Paradis, asked for information relative to development of land off Fisher Street. He was informed that because of the insufficient width of the extension of Belknap Street, that the proposed subdivision would not be approved.

Mr. McDonald directed the Planning Board Director to set in motion the necessary steps to obtain a rehearing relative to the rezoning of the Emerson property off Silver Street from single residence to commercial to allow the installation of a gasoline station.

The subdivision of Peter Callahan was discussed. A formal petition will be drawn relative to extension of the water main from Old Tolend and New Tolend Road.

There were insufficient members present for a quorum, therefore, the meeting was adjourned.
