A special meeting of the Dover Planning Board was called to order by Chairman Eugene S. Meserve at 5:10 p. m., Monday, March 14, 1960 in the Board Office. The secretary called the roll. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the secretary. On motion by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Grimes, it was voted to amend the minutes to omit that section of the Staff report making reference to the proposed subdivision of Riverview Park.

Chairman Meserve introduced the proposed Subdivision Regulations, on which a public hearing was held March 7, 1960, for the consideration of the Board. It was moved by Mr. Grimes, seconded by Mr. Fox, that the following be struck from Section V, Paragraph 6, "...shall be no longer than 1000 feet and...". Following discussion, Mr. Grimes motioned for the question and requested a roll call vote. The secretary called the roll:

McDonald: No.

Fox: Yes.

Grimes: Yes.

Meserve: No.

DuBois: No.


The Chairman inquired if there were further discussion. He indicated that he awaited a motion for acceptance of the proposed Subdivision Regulations.

On motion by Mr. Grimes, seconded by Mr. DuBois, it was voted unanimously to adopt the proposed revision of the Subdivision Regulations as presented at the March 7 public hearing.

It was suggested by Mr. Grimes that percolation test information be added to the application form which is to be submitted with the request for subdivision. The other members of the Board concurred.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p. m.
