Chairman Eugene Meserve called a special meeting of the Planning Board to order at 10:10 a. m., April 9, 1960 at the Board Office. Secretary Arthur J. DuBois called the roll. The order of business was a recommendation to the Mayor concerning the refuse disposal problem.

Following a lengthy discussion, it was unanimously voted, on motion by Arthur DuBois, seconded by Robert Labrie, that the Planning Board write to the Mayor that the Planning Board sent a report, concerning refuse disposal to the Mayor and Council for study and action. After reviewing the study on Saturday, April 9, 1960, the Planning Board believes that it is still applicable to the conditions which exist in the City today. *June 13, 1957*

The Chairman directed the Planning Director to consult with the New Hampshire State Pollution Commission and the State Board of Health concerning the refuse disposal problem.

The members of the Board agreed to view "The Hoppers" at the conclusion of the meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 11:05 a. m.
