Chairman Eugene S. Meserve called a special meeting of the Planning Board to order at 7:40 P.M. in the Board Office. Mr. Meserve explained that the meeting had been called for the purpose of meeting with the Dover Housing Authority to discuss the proposal Low Cost Housing for the Elderly and for Large Families.

Maurice E. Witmer, architect for the projects, explained the details of the proposed developments. The large family units will be adjacent to the present low cost units at Mineral Park and will number 60. The housing for the elderly will be located in Smalley Field at the end of Union Street and will consist of 40 units. The members of the Planning Board made inquiries concerning various aspects of the project.

Mr. Mc Cann explained that a letter from the Planning Board indicating the Board's approval would be necessary. He stated that the Housing Authority hoped to issue requests for bids before the end of September.

Mr. Meserve advised Mr. Mc Cann that the Planning Board would take action at the earliest possible date.

On motion by Mr. Labrie, seconded by Mr. Grimes, the Minutes of the July 25, 1960 and July 28, 1960 meeting were approved as distributed.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:25 on motion by Mr. Labrie, seconded by Mr. DuBois.
