Chairman Eugene S. Meserve called the regular monthly meeting of the Planning Board to order at 7:30 P.M. October 2, 1961 in the Board Office.

The roll was called by Secretary Arthur J. DuBois with six members present, three members absent.

A communication from Mrs. Ida Hooz requesting an eight month extension of preliminary approval of Riverview Park Development was read. On motion by Arthur DuBois, seconded by Laurence Nealley, it was voted to grant the extension.

The Planning Director requested $1\frac{1}{2}$ days leave during the week of October 9 in order to attend to educational business in New York. On motion by Laurence R. Nealley, seconded by Arthur J. DuBois, it was voted unanimously to grant the request.

Following a briefing on the rezoning of Dover Point from Mayrand's Furniture to Cote Drive from Tourist Business to Single Residence which was completed in June, 1960, the Board members attended an informal gathering of several citizens of the Dover Point Area. Their views were heard by the Board and the Board assured those present that everything would be done to correct the situation.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:15 p.m. on motion by Albert Bernard, seconded by Arthur DuBois.
