On February 15, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. Timothy Granfield, Chair, made the following statement:

“I find that there is an “emergency” within the meaning of RSA 91-A:2, III(b) because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, which has led to various restrictions by state authorities and additional recommended limitations on being in public for symptomatic or high-risk individuals, or gathering in large numbers, all of which have resulted in an inability or inadvisability, or both, of a quorum being physically present for this meeting. It is imperative the Board of Commissioners of the Dover Housing Authority hold regular meetings. Furthermore, there is no anticipated or foreseeable end date for the current restrictions and recommended limitations.”

Four (4) board members are participating in the Meeting. Patricia Silberblatt and Noreen Biehl qualify for vulnerable status regarding Covid 19 and appear by telephone. Timothy Granfield and Rachel Stansfield also appear by telephone. A quorum is achieved by the participation by telephone by four (4) board members.
