Chairman Eugene S. Meserve called the meeting of the Planning Board to order at 7:40 p.m., Monday, January 29, 1962, in the Board Office.

Secretary Arthur J. DuBois called the roll.

The Planning Director reported that a Member of the City Council had consulted with her relative to recommendations concerning the reconstruction of the Whittier Street Bridge. In the conversation, the increasing development in the section of the City serviced by Whittier Street was pointed out. The Planning Director stated she had suggested that a sidewalk be included in the reconstruction plans due to increased pedestrian traffic in the area.

The Board reviewed briefly, without conclusion, minimum lot sizes for areas not serviced by the municipal sewer system.

The Board reviewed the problem of control of location of mobilehomes. On motion by Arthur DuBois, seconded by Albert Bernard, it was voted to recommend to the City Council that the Building Code be amended to clarify the definition of "building".

The Board also reviewed without conclusion, the problem of storage of boats in "residential areas."

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
