In the absence of the Chairman, on motion by Ambrose Breen, seconded by Albert O. Bernard, E. Vincent McDonald was designated acting Chairman. The Planning Director advised the members of the Board that Raymond Hennessey, proprietor of Lipson's Produce, was present to answer questions that the Board might have relative to the four lots which he had reserved to his own use from the tract of Colonial Park Subdivision.

Following a lengthy discussion by the Board members and the interested parties present, concerning storm drainage, as well as the flow of water over adjacent properties, certificates from the local Health Department relative to the installation of septic tanks, Water Department regulations, and subdivision design, it was voted by the Board to delay action on the application until such a time as the Board had viewed the site of the proposed subdivision. Members of the Board agreed to assemble at the site on Saturday, March 17, at 11 a.m.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:10 p.m.
