DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Ms. Russell read the following statement:

“I find an ‘emergency; exists within the meaning of RSA 91-A:2, III(b). Immediate action is imperative, and the physical presence of a quorum is not reasonably practical within the period of time requiring action. The facts on which my find of an ‘emergency’ is based are the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the need to accommodate social distancing and minimization of in person contacts, and this body’s ongoing, immediate need to address the important matters on the agenda for this meeting.”

A. CALL TO ORDER: Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, February 1, 2021 at 6:02 p.m.

B. ROLL CALL: Present were Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Carolyn Mebert, Zachary Koehler, Kathy Morrison, Jessica Rozzo and Rachel Burdin.

Also present were: Superintendent Bill Harbron, Business Administrator Michael Limanni, Assistant Superintendents Christine Boston and Paula Glynn, IT Director Christy Prosser, and District Administrators Peter Driscoll, Kim Lyndes, Patrick Boodey, Beth Dunton, Patty Driscoll, and Peter Wotton.

C. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Jessica Rozzo led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. CITIZENS FORUM (Limited to agenda items only): None

E. NOMINATIONS:

Zachary Koehler moved; Carolyn Mebert seconded to approve the nominations presented. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 7/0.**

F. COVID-19 DATA UPDATE:

Dr. Boston provided an update on the current COVID-19 data. The District currently has two staff who have tested positive, twenty staff under quarantine, nine students who have tested positive and seventy-three students under quarantine. Dr. Boston informed the Board the student transmission did not occur in the school setting.

G. DOVER MIDDLE SCHOOL AND DOVER HIGH SCHOOL PHASE-IN PLAN FOR IN-PERSON LEARNING:

District administrators Ms. Lyndes and Mr. Driscoll provided an overview of the Dover Middle School and Dover High School phase-in plan.

Keith Holt moved; Carolyn Mebert seconded to approve the Dover Middle School and Dover High School reentry plan presented. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 7/0.**



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H. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS REENTRY PLAN:

Mr. Holt inquired to the current staffing of the elementary schools, to which Dr. Harbron responded Dr. Boston is working through the ADA list currently. He also noted that the District is hoping to provide each school with four substitutes on a continual basis.

I. MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR DOVER TEACHERS UNION, DOVER PARAEDUCATORS UNION AND DOVER EXECUTIVE OFFICE PERSONNEL UNION:

Keith Holt moved; Zachary Koehler seconded to approve Memorandum of Agreement. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 7/0.**

J. MATTERS OF INTEREST:

Amanda Russell reminded the public of the District's need for substitute teachers.

Keith Holt reminded the public of the HB 20 state voucher bill which pertains to public funds remaining with public education. If people are opposed, he requests they submit their opposition.

Amanda Russell reminds the public that effective February 8, schools will return to their regularly scheduled hours.
