Notice is hereby given that the Zoning Board of Adjustment for the City of Dover, N.H. will hold a Public Hearing December 5, 1961 at 7:30 P.M. in the Police Court Room, Municipal Building for the Following purpose:

Appellant, George J. O'Neil who is the owner of property at 102 Central Avenue Lot #15-80 and at 106 Central Avenue Lot #15-101 shown on the Assessor's map, respectfully petitions the Board of Appeals of the City of Dover to permit an exception to the regulations of the Zoning Ordinance relating to the property, as provided by Section 6, Paragraph D₂, appeals of said Zoning Ordinance.

The appeal is for the authorization to extend a non-conforming use, (gasoline service station) into a general residence district. Requesting twenty additional feet on the souther side-line of Lot #101 Map 15 owned by appellant George J. O'Neil and also to replace present existing building (gasoline service station) with a new modern building.
