DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

- A. CALL TO ORDER:** Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, June 7, 2021 at 7:02 p.m.
- B. ROLL CALL:** Present were Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Carolyn Mebert, Zachary Koehler, Jessica Rozzo and Rachel Burdin. Kathy Morrison was excused.

Also present were: Superintendent Bill Harbron, Business Administrator Michael Limanni, and District Administrators Patrick Boodey, and Peter Wotton.

C. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Rachel Burdin led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. CITIZENS FORUM (Limited to agenda items only): None

E. REVIEW OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET:

Keith Holt moved; Zachary Koehler seconded the motion that based upon the rejection of the Dover School District's operating budget authorized in the previous year, reduced and increased as the case may be by debt service, contracts, and other obligations previously incurred or mandated by law, by the Dover City Council on June 2, 2021, that the Dover School District elect to pay the Dover teachers pursuant to the 2020-2021 salary scale during the 2021-2022 school year as provided for under Article XIV (14) of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Dover School Board and the Dover Teacher's Union NEA/NH. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 6/0.**

Mr. Limanni reviewed the Fiscal Year 2022 Tax Capped Budget.

Carolyn Mebert moved; Keith Holt seconded to approve the amended general fund operating budget totaling \$66,811,056. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 6/0.**

Keith Holt moved; Carolyn Mebert seconded to adopt the revised Fiscal Year 2022 budget of \$73,286,839 which included the tax capped operating budget of \$61,684,795, debt service of \$6,439,335 and special revenue funds estimated at \$5,162,709. **A roll call VOTE PASSED 6/0.**

F. MATTERS OF INTEREST:

Mr. Koehler received inquiries regarding masks during athletics. Mr. Wotton responded student athletes have not been required to wear masks outdoors for the last few weeks. Dr. Harbron responded the Dover Medical Advisory Council recommended students continue to wear masks in the buildings due to many students remaining unvaccinated.

Dr. Mebert inquired about the publishing teacher salaries, to which Mr. Limanni responded the City will be posting that for all District employees.
