The Committee interviewed Bobbie Glidden for a position on the Graffiti Management Ad-Hoc Committee.

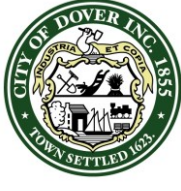
The Committee interviewed Hadley Hudson for a position on a board or commission.
