5. Staff Updates

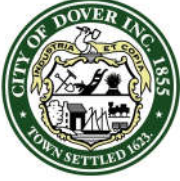
- A. VW NHDES RFP - Looking for 2-4 fast current chargers per location. Targeting Rt. 16 Corridor. Possible, C&J site. Feasibility assessment required. Deadline pushed to January.
- B. CPCNH - First meeting held Oct. 1. Currently 14 communities represented. 1.5 yrs. to figure out ways to get involved.
- C. RFP for Fire Dept. EVSE - Looking to install two level 2 chargers at N. End Fire Station.
- D. Electric Street Sweeper - 2x price of diesel sweepers. Potential proposal for subsidizing the cost through a proposal.
