



DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, October 4, 2021, at 6:05 p.m.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Carolyn Mebert, Rachel Burdin, Zachary Koehler, Jessica Rozzo, and Kathy Morrison. Also present was Superintendent William Harbron, Business Administrator Michael Limanni, and Superintendent Christine Boston.

Zachary Koehler moved, Carolyn Mebert seconded, to enter a non-public session at 6:05 p.m. to discuss RSA 91-A:3 II(c), Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.

A roll call VOTE PASSED 7/0. (All in favor).

The Board entered a non-public session to review a manifest hardship request.

The Board re-entered public session at 6:48 p.m.

The Board discussed whether the minutes of the nonpublic session would be sealed and all in attendance determined that they would be sealed.
